

SEWER PERMITS

When a facility is going to connect to the sewer, they first need to contact the Administrative office to seek approval for the connection permit and pay the permit fee. There is a \$70.00 permit fee.

Information, such as location, address and type of building or structure to be served must be submitted at the time fees are paid at the Administrative office.

All connections must be inspected before burial. Inspections must be scheduled twenty four (24) hours in advance by notifying the operations office at 260-351-2163. **No Weekend Inspections!**

*Those that are not purchasing water will be required to install a manhole, and flow meter on the discharge line, as specified by the Operations Manager of the LaGrange County Utility District.

All sewer lateral installations must be performed by an Indiana licensed plumber.

All restaurants and all food preparation establishments must have a 1,000 gallon in-ground grease trap, or a grease removal process approved by the Operations Manager of the Utility District.

All gravity lateral pipes to the main, and all gravity laterals to a grinder pump must be SDR 21 pipe.

Additional plumbing requirements are listed on the connect permits.
